In addition to the "early adopters", including the ISO 30301, now is the turn of adaptations and changes in the existing standards. The process produces many questions and resistance to change.

The more advanced committees are :

- ISO 27001, have done all the work and have sent a report to the TMB for authorizing them some deviations from the original text

- ISO 14001, have begun preliminary work and have a number of doubts and questions di scussed in the meeting

- ISO 50001, in very early stage have also some basic questions to be solved

The ISO 30301was published before the final version that appears in Annex SL, so it is 90% alligned
