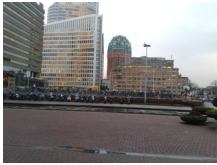


Meeting of working group on revision of ISO 15489 in The Hague

At the end of January 2014 was held at The Hague a meeting of **ISO Working Group** on the revision of the ISO 15489 standard.

The work is progressing at a fast pace but are still in the stage of working group draft.

Some of the conclusions of the working group to note were:

- Separate **principles** from the implementation issues, leading to a structure similar to the current one in different parts.
- Highlight the importance of the **analysis processes** that underlie the whole records management, and are performed before the creation of records. Very interesting is the inclusion of appraisal at this point.
- The distinction between **metadata** at the point of capture and process metadata .

If work continues as expected in the coming months, the draft will be balloted for adoption as a draft of the Committee. But its final publication will not be before 2015.
